One of the accepted forms of photo Voter ID is the Biometric Residence Permit (BRP), but important changes are happening.

A BRP is an official document that shows someone's immigration status in the UK. It is used to confirm your:

- identity
- right to study
- right to work
- right to any public services or benefits you're entitled to



However, all BRPs expire on 31st December 2024. From the 1st January 2025, you will need to use the eVisa system to prove your immigration status.

Updating your physical document to an eVisa does not affect your immigration status or the conditions of your permission to enter or stay in the UK.
