Londoners, first of all, make sure you register to vote. It takes a few minutes, if you head to www.gov.uk/register-to-vote

You must be aged 16 or over; a London resident; and a British, Irish, Commonwealth or EU citizen.

## There are three types of elections in London:







General/parliamentary elections



Local/borough elections

British, Irish and Commonwealth citizens are eligible to vote in Mayor of London/London Assembly elections, General/ parliamentary elections, and Local/borough elections.

EU citizens are only eligible to vote in Mayor of London/ London Assembly elections and Local/borough elections.

## Accepted forms of photo ID

Secondly, make sure you have and can present one of these accepted forms of photo ID to vote in person, at the polling station:

- UK, Channel Islands or EEA driving licence
- UK, Commonwealth or EEA passport
  - National identity card issued by an EEA state
- Biometric immigration document
- Blue Badge scheme card
  - 60+ Oyster photocard or a Freedom Pass
- Identity card bearing the Proof of Age Standards Scheme hologram (a PASS card)
- Ministry of Defence Form 90
